#### Aims and Content

In the summer semester of 2024, FH Campus Wien will host the first INUAS COIL Days. The event will centre around the practical implementation of Virtual Exchange/COIL (Collaborative Online International Learning) projects. Participants will have the opportunity to get together with colleagues from other INUAS universities (FH Campus Wien, Hochschule München, Zurich University of Applied Sciences) as well as some of our international partner universities, and to exchange their knowledge and experiences of implementing Virtual Exchange in the classroom. Participants will be shown practical examples by colleagues and will receive input from COIL experts to help them internationalise their own teaching and to find ideas and partners for future COIL projects.

#### Key takeaways

- develop their own Virtual Exchange/COIL project
- find Virtual Exchange/COIL partners within and beyond the INUAS network
- implement Virtual Exchange/COIL projects within and across disciplines
