Nomination deadline	Winter Semester & Full Year: June 5 st Summer Semester: November 15 th
Application deadline	Winter Semester & Full Year: June 20 th Summer Semester: December 1 st
How to apply?	All students must be nominated by their home University. Selected students have to send in the following documents, before the application deadline, to exchange students @ue-varna.bg for checking: 1) Application Form 2) Learning Agreement 3) Housing Application (where applicable) After approval, the original documents + 4 passport-size photos (3.5 x 4.5 cm) must be sent by post to the university address
Tuition fees	All exchange incoming students coming from partner universities are exempt from any tuition fees

Visa	All Non-European students must have a valid VISA. In order to apply for it, they must receive an admission letter.
Language skills	All students enrolled in an exchange program must have a minimum level of B1-B2 in the language of instruction. All students enrolled in an exchange program leading to a diploma of the University of Economics - Varna must have a minimum level of B2 in the language of instruction.
